# THE WEDDING CHECKLIST

Planning a wedding can feel overwhelming, but breaking it down month by month makes the process so much smoother—and even fun! This comprehensive 12-month wedding checklist will help you stay organised, on schedule, and stress-free. From choosing your venue to saying "I do," this guide walks you through each essential step leading up to your big day.

#### 12 - 18 MONTHS

Plan your budget and make it realistic
Pick at least 3 flexible dates
Create your Pinterest mood boards
Choose a wedding style & theme
Determine your wedding party & guest list
Plan your engagement photos, if you are having them
Look for venues: church, venues, registry office
Research wedding suppliers, photographers, videographers,
caterer, florists, and DJs
Consider getting a wedding insurance
Look for wedding dresses and suits styles
Prepare and order your Save The Date and invitations

#### 10 - 11 MONTHS

Choose outfits for your Bridal Party
Reserve ceremony and reception venues
Book your wedding suppliers, photographers, videographers,
caterer, florists, DJs and officiant
Buy dresses/suits for you and your Bridal Party
Finalise your guest list
Send your invites and RSVP's
Decide on your wedding decorations with your supplier or
gather items to create your own



# 8 - 9 MONTHS

Plan your honeymoon (book flights & hotel rooms)
Prepare wedding invitations & cards (menu cards, thank you
notes)
Book hotel rooms for guests if you are booking them, otherwise
ask guests to book their own
Create gift list
Look for your makeup & hairstyle inspirations and create a board
on Pinterest
Book your hair & make up

#### 6 - 7 MONTHS

Book in to give notice at your local council
Reserve whatever item that's not included at the venue: lights,
chairs, tables, etc.
Schedule a wedding cake/dessert tasting
Decide on the food menu
Finalize your wedding music
Books transportations to venues
Purchase wedding bands
Purchase Thank You cards



### 4 - 5 MONTHS

Choose your florals and table design
Schedule Dress Fitting
Order Your Cake
Book a room for your wedding night
Finalise songs: Ceremony music - 1 for entrance, 1 for signing the
register and 1 for exit. Another song for your entrance as Mr &
Mrs and First Dance
Finalise guest list and start arranging table plans

#### 3 MONTHS

Finalise and ready honeymoon plans and needed things
Finalise table plans and any reserved seats for the ceremony
Invite additional Evening Reception guests
Finalise all drinks and food menus
Purchase or make a guest book and any decor or fun bits
Order Menu Cards and Wedding Favours or create your own
Purchase gifts for the Bridal Party and parents



# 2 MONTHS

Check and update RSVP list
Write your wedding vows if needed and plan speeches
Finalise the wedding running order of the day, see example at the
end of the checklist
Finalise fittings for suits and dresses
Confirm all timings and arrivals of the wedding suppliers
Get "Something Old, New, Borrowed, Blue"
Book a bridal car if needed
Pick up wedding rings
Buy shoes and undergarments
Make a list of things for your wedding bag, tissues, lipstick, mirror,
plasters etc
1 MONTH
Settle all payments
Confirm honeymoon reservations
Pack for honeymoon, purchase anything you need
Make playlist for all songs to be played
Confirm all details with wedding venue



# 2 WEEKS

Final fitting for the wedding dress and arrange collection
Makeup and hair trials if not had them yet
Give the caterer the final count - no more changes
Prepare wedding day emergency kit and bathroom baskets
☐ Break-in wedding shoes
Send playlists to DJ/band
Settle other necessary payments
Meet with the photographer to discuss requests
Delegate wedding duties to the Wedding Party

# 1 WEEK

Get a haircut and colour, book tanning and any beauty
appointments
Prepare all wedding clothes and accessories
Arrange with the venue when you can drop things off
Arrange with the cake provider if/when you can collect or they
can drop off to the venue



#### 1 DAY BEFORE

Make sure nails are done
Clean engagement ring with washing up liquid and soft
toothbrush if not polished
☐ Get a good night's sleep
Eat a good breakfast the next morning and drink lots of water

# AFTER THE WEDDING

Return all items if needed to be returned
Get wedding dress cleaned and boxed for safe keeping
Send out Thank You cards to guests
Get photos and video from your suppliers
Leave reviews for suppliers
